Sponsored by: County Executive FitzGerald/County Engineer	A Resolution making an award on RQ18841 and authorizing the County Executive to enter into a contract with Karvo Paving, Co. in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,451,287.26 for repair and resurfacing of Hillside Road from Broadview Road to Brecksville Road in the cities of Independence and Seven Hills; declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the repair and resurfacing of Hillside Road from Broadview Road to Brecksville Road in the cities of Independence and Seven Hills has been found to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer reported that its office received bids on December 8, 2010, tabulated the extension of prices submitted by each bidder and verified the accuracy of the total amounts; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the County Engineer found Karvo Paving, Co. to be the lowest qualified bidder and that Karvo submitted all necessary documentation per the proposal, plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the County Executive is authorized to enter into a contract with Karvo Paving, Co. (RQ18841) in the amount not to exceed \$1,451,287.26 for the repair and resurfacing of Hillside Road from Broadview Road to Brecksville Road in the cities of Independence and Seven Hills.

SECTION 2. Funds have been certified and encumbered sufficient to fund this contract.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue, and to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution

receives the affirmative vote of eight members elected to Council, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
