

# County Council of Cuyahoga County, Ohio

## Resolution No. R2011-0029

Sponsored by <b>County Executive FitzGerald/County Engineer</b>	<b>A Resolution</b> approving specifications and estimate of cost in the amount not-to-exceed \$6,770,000.00 for construction of a grade separation on Fitch Road over the Norfolk Southern Railroad in the City of Olmsted Falls and Olmsted Township; authorizing the Department of Purchasing to advertise for bids on RQ19284, and declaring the necessity that this resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the County Engineer is administering a federally funded project and has planned for the construction of a grade separation on Fitch Road over the Norfolk Southern Railroad in the City of Olmsted Falls and Olmsted Township; and,

WHEREAS, the County Engineer is submitting specifications and estimates of costs for the project; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to advertise for bids to obtain a qualified contractor to complete construction per plan at the lowest cost to the County;

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County department;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the specifications and estimate of cost in the amount not-to-exceed \$6,770,000.00 on RQ19284 for construction of a grade separation on Fitch Road over the Norfolk Southern Railroad in the City of Olmsted Falls and Olmsted Township are hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** That the Department of Purchasing is authorized to advertise for bids on RQ19284 consistent with Section 1 above.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue, and to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members elected to Council, this

Resolution shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
