Sponsored by: County Executive FitzGerald/ Department of Public Works/ Department of Central Services	A Resolution authorizing the Department of Purchasing on behalf of the County Executive to issue Addendum No. 3 to the specifications on RQ18560 for the Corrections Center Jail Kitchen Renovation Project, to make technical changes and to change the bid due date from 1/13/2011 to 1/20/2011, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the County, through the Office of Procurement and Diversity and the Department of Central Services, has advertised for bids on RQ18560 for the Corrections Center Jail Kitchen Renovation Project (the “Project”);

WHEREAS, the Department of Central Services recommends revising the specifications for the Project, recommends other technical changes, and recommends changing the bid due date from January 13, 2011 to January 20, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this resolution become immediately effective in order to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the revised specifications for the Project are hereby approved and the County Executive, through Department of Purchasing and the Department of Central Services, is authorized to distribute Addendum No. 2 on RQ18560 for the Corrections Center Jail Kitchen Renovation.

SECTION 2. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members elected to Council, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the

public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
