Sponsored by: County Executive FitzGerald/Department of Purchasing	A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a contract (No. CE1100097-01) with Great Lakes Petroleum Co. in the amount not-to-exceed \$304,000.00 for middle distillates for various County facilities for the period 1/1/2011 - 12/31/2011, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the Department of Purchasing has recommended a contract be entered into with Great Lakes Petroleum Co. in the amount not-to-exceed \$304,000.00 for the furnishing of Middle Distillates which will supply the Cuyahoga County Engineer, Cuyahoga County Sanitary Engineer, Department of Central Services and the Department of Development for the period 1/1/2011 through 12/31/2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the County Executive is authorized to enter into a contract (No. CE1100097-01) with Great Lakes Petroleum Co. in the amount not-to-exceed \$304,000.00 for middle distillates for various County facilities for the period 1/1/2011 - 12/31/2011.

SECTION 2. Funds have been certified and encumbered sufficient to fund this contract.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue, and to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members elected to Council, this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting

of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
