## Resolution No. R2011-0042

Sponsored by: <b>County Executive FitzGerald/Department of Public Works/County Engineer</b>	A <b>Resolution</b> authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement of cooperation with City of North Royalton for reconstruction of Royalton Road, with additional turning lanes, from West 130 <sup>th</sup> Street to York Road, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the County Engineer has requested the approval of an agreement of cooperation with the City of North Royalton, for the improvement of Royalton Road (CR-82) from West 130<sup>th</sup> Street to York Road within the corporate limits of the City of North Royalton (the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, funding for the project is as follows:

County Share:	\$488,000.00
Federal Share:	\$9,760,000.00
Issue 1 Share:	\$1,464,000.00
Municipal Share:	\$488,000.00
Total Estimate Cost:	\$12, 200,000.00; and,

Whereas, the project is expected to be bid in 2013.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The County Executive is authorized to enter into an Agreement of Cooperation with the City of North Royalton for the improvement of Royalton Road (CR-82) from West 130<sup>th</sup> Street to York Road within the corporate limits of the City of North Royalton.


**SECTION 2.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members elected to Council, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
