Sponsored by: <b>County Executive FitzGerald/Department of Health and Human Services/Office of Homeless Services</b>	<b>A Resolution</b> authorizing the County Executive to enter into a contract with The Salvation Army in the amount not-to-exceed \$527,499.00 for the PASS Transitional Housing Program in connection with the FY2009 Continuum of Care for Homeless Assistance Grant Program for the period 10/1/2010 - 9/30/2011, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive has submitted a contract a contract with the Salvation Army in the amount not-to-exceed \$527,499.00 for the PASS Transitional Housing Program in connection with the FY2009 Continuum of Care for Homeless Assistance Grant Program for the period 10/1/2010 - 9/30/2011; and,

WHEREAS, the Salvation Army, a non-profit organization, was awarded RENEWAL funding through the FY 2009 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Grant process; and,

WHEREAS, the County acts as the applicant for this grant and serves as a pass through for the funds to the Salvation Army; and,

WHEREAS, the funding will maintain a transitional housing program for single men located at the Harbor Light Complex, 1710 Prospect Avenue that currently serves 75 men; and,

WHEREAS, the program provides a sober environment, job readiness, and job placement assistance and the goal is to return clients to permanent housing, with the means to sustain themselves, as quickly as possible.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Salvation Army in the amount not-to-exceed \$527,499.00 for the PASS Transitional Housing Program in connection with the FY2009 Continuum of Care for Homeless Assistance Grant Program for the period 10/1/2010 - 9/30/2011.

**SECTION 2.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue, and to continue the usual and daily operation of the County. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members of Council, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon the signature of the County Executive.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


