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WHEREAS, on November 3, 2010, the former governing body of Cuyahoga County approved Resolution No. 104840 providing for certain County appropriations; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 104840 by correcting a numerical discrepancy in a line item; and

WHEREAS, amendment is necessary for reconciliation of the 2010 appropriations in the County's financial system; and,

WHEREAS, it is further necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of County departments, offices, and agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:
