

# County Council of Cuyahoga County, Ohio

## Resolution No. R2014-0066

Sponsored by: **County Executive FitzGerald/Department of Public Works**

**A Resolution** making an award on RQ29217 to Sterling Professional Group, LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$876,150.00 for the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections Elevator Modernization Project; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Public Works recommended an award on RQ29217 to Sterling Professional Group, LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$876,150.00 for the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections Elevator Modernization Project; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal is to provide construction services for the elevator repair and modernization project located at the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections, 2925 Euclid Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded by 2012 Limited Tax General Obligation Bond; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby makes an award on RQ29217 to Sterling Professional Group, LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$876,150.00 for the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections Elevator Modernization Project.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute a contract in connection with said award and all documents consistent with this Resolution.


**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


On a motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Germana, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted.
