## Resolution No. R2015-0086

<p>Sponsored by: <b>County Executive Budish/Department of Health and Human Services/Division of Children and Family Services</b></p> <p>Co-sponsored by: <b>Councilmember Hairston</b></p>	<p><b>A Resolution</b> authorizing amendments to contracts with various providers for emergency assistance services for the period 9/1/2012 - 4/30/2015 to extend the time period to 4/30/2018 and for additional funds; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendments and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.</p>
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WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Health and Human Services/ Division of Children and Family Services has recommended to amend contracts with various providers for emergency assistance services for the period 9/1/2012 – 4/30/2015 to extend the time period to 4/30/2018 and for additional funds as follows:

- a) No. CE1200402-01 with A-Z Furniture Co., Inc. to change the terms, effective 5/1/2015, and in the amount not-to-exceed \$336,000.00;
- b) No. CE1200403-01 with Dave’s Supermarket in the amount not-to-exceed \$126,000.00;
- c) No. CE1200405-01 with West 25<sup>th</sup> Furnishings and Appliances, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$777,000.00;
- d) No. CE1200560-02 with Burlington Coat Factory of Ohio, LLC dba Burlington Coat Factory in the amount not-to-exceed \$861,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the program is provide emergency assistance services (food, clothing, household/children furniture items) that are required to mitigate risk of abuse/neglect and/or to facilitate placement of children outside their own homes; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded 79% with Federal Emergency Services Funds and 21% with funds from the Health and Human Services Levy; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes amendments to contracts with various providers for emergency assistance services for the period 9/1/2012 – 4/30/2015 to extend the time period to 4/30/2018 and for additional funds as follows:

- a) No. CE1200402-01 with A-Z Furniture Co., Inc. to change the terms, effective 5/1/2015, and in the amount not-to-exceed \$336,000.00.
- b) No. CE1200403-01 with Dave's Supermarket in the amount not-to-exceed \$126,000.00.
- c) No. CE1200405-01 with West 25<sup>th</sup> Furnishings and Appliances, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$777,000.00.
- d) No. CE1200560-02 with Burlington Coat Factory of Ohio, LLC dba Burlington Coat Factory in the amount not-to-exceed \$861,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute the amendments and all documents consistent with this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

On a motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Miller, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted.
