

# County Council of Cuyahoga County, Ohio

## Resolution No. R2015-0155

Sponsored by: **County Executive Budish**

**A Resolution** confirming the County Executive's appointment of Sheryl Harris, upon her taking the oath of office, as Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Council established a Department of Consumer Affairs and the powers and duties of the Director of Consumer Affairs in Ordinance No. O2011-0053; and

WHEREAS, Section 202.16 of Chapter 202 of the Cuyahoga County Code provides for the functions, goals and activities of the Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has nominated Sheryl Harris to the position of Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Council has undergone review and scheduled a Confirmation Hearing which was noticed to the public and held in an open meeting on September 8, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Council elects to confirm the County Executive's appointment of Sheryl Harris to the position of Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that Charter requirements can be complied with and critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue, and to provide for the usual, daily operation of County government.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby confirms the appointment of Sheryl Harris to serve as the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs upon her taking the oath of office.

**SECTION 2.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided

that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members of Council, this Resolution shall become immediately effective.

**SECTION 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

On a motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Miller, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted.
