WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Health and Human Services/Division of Community Initiatives/Office of Early Childhood has recommended a Contract with City of Cleveland, Department of Public Health in the amount not-to-exceed \$682,276.00 for prenatal and inter-conceptional care services to high-risk families in connection with the expansion of the MomsFirst Program for the Invest in Children Program for the period 1/1/2022 – 12/31/2023; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of this project are to: (a) reduce infant mortality; and (b) reduce low and extremely low birth weight; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded 100% by Health and Human Services Levy; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes a Contract with City of Cleveland, Department of Public Health in the amount not-to-exceed \$682,276.00 for prenatal and inter-conceptional care services to high-risk families in connection with the expansion of the MomsFirst Program for the Invest in Children Program for the period 1/1/2022 – 12/31/2023.
