Resolution No. R2022-0367

Sponsored by: County Executive Budish/Department of Public Works	A Resolution declaring the vacation of a certain portion of Station Road located in the City of Brecksville in connection with Cleveland Metropolitan Park improvements is of sufficient importance to prepare a plat and survey; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
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WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council adopted Resolution No. R2022-0319 on September 28, 2022 which authorized the vacation of a certain portion of Station Road located in the City of Brecksville, Ohio, setting the date, time and place for a view and date, time and place for a final hearing in connection with said vacation; and

WHEREAS, County Council viewed said Property on October 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, County Council after such viewing of the Property considers the same of sufficient public importance to have a plat and survey made; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby declares the vacation of a certain portion of Station Road located in the City of Brecksville in connection with intersection improvements is of sufficient importance to prepare a plat and survey.

SECTION 2. That the County Engineer is hereby requested to prepare a plat and survey of the proposed vacation of a certain portion of Station Road located in the City of Brecksville, as described above, and submit same to County Council with his report thereon.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of

the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

On a motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Schron, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted.
