## Resolution No. R2023-0103

<b>Sponsored by: County Executive Ronayne/Department of Development</b>	<b>A Resolution</b> authorizing an Economic Development Loan in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000.00 to Skyline Renaissance LLC, or its designee, to assist with funding project costs for the renovation and revitalization of the Cleveland Renaissance Hotel located at 24 Public Square, City of Cleveland which contains 491 rooms and has 870,000 square feet; authorizing the County Executive and/or the Director of Development to execute all documents consistent with said loan and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive/Department of Development recommends an Economic Development Loan in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000.00 to Skyline Renaissance LLC, or its designee, to assist with funding project costs for the renovation and revitalization of the Cleveland Renaissance Hotel located at 24 Public Square, City of Cleveland which contains 491 rooms and has 870,000 square feet; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary goal of this loan is assists in funding project costs for renovation and revitalization of the Cleveland Renaissance Hotel; and

**WHEREAS**, this project is anticipated to create 126 new jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, the total cost of the project is approximately \$90,779,578.00 of which the County will loan \$2,000,000.00 with a term of 15 years at an interest rate of 4.5%, interest only for the first year, the remaining 14 years will be fully-amortizing principal and interest payments; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is funded by 100% Economic Development Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an Economic Development Loan in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000.00 to Skyline Renaissance

LLC, or its designee, to assist with funding project costs for the renovation and revitalization of the Cleveland Renaissance Hotel located at 24 Public Square, City of Cleveland which contains 491 rooms and has 870,000 square feet.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive and/or the Director of Development is authorized to execute all documents consistent with said loan and this Resolution. To the extent that any exemptions are necessary under the County Code and contracting procedures, they shall be deemed approved by the adoption of this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall sunset twelve (12) months after County Council approval should the authorized action have not occurred by that date. In the event this Resolution sunsets prior to the authorized action taking place, the Director of Development shall notify the Clerk of Council in writing. The Clerk of Council shall record the sunseting of this Resolution in the Council's journal.

**SECTION 4.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County and the reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 5.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

On a motion by Mr. Schron, seconded by Ms. Conwell, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted.
