CUYAHOGA COUNTY COUNCIL TO HOLD ETHICS TRAINING SESSION

Cleveland, OH - On Tuesday, December 11, 2012, at 4:00 p.m., Cuyahoga County Council will hold a Work Session at which the County's Human Resources Department will offer its annual Ethics Training session for Council Members. Annual ethics training for all county public officials and employees is a requirement of the County's Ethics Ordinance. First enacted by the Council in early 2011, the Cuyahoga County's Ethics Ordinance is the most comprehensive ethics law in the State of Ohio.
